Message of support to the striking Tesco drivers

Dear brothers/sisters,

The Scottish Socialist Party extends the hand of workers' solidarity to you as you strike against bully-boy bosses.

These money-grabbing multi-national gangsters cannot be allowed to play the old divide-and-rule trick, attacking Scottish drivers today, the rest of the 5,000 UK Tesco drivers tomorrow. **Unity is our strength - unity in action.**
